

<u>Key Instant Recall Facts</u> <u>Year 5 - Autumn 1</u>

Focus: Multiplication and division facts for all times tables up to 12×12 Aim: The aim is for children to recall these facts instantly.

The Year 5 children should already know **ALL** the times tables up to 12×12 . This half term is a chance for children to recap and consolidate their knowledge of multiplication and division facts and to increase their speed of recall.

Top Tips/Activity ideas

Little and often is the best way for children to retain these key facts. Practice them whilst on the way to school, during a car journey or at the kitchen table. You don't need to practice them all at once: start with one particular times tables and ensure children know all of them before moving on.

Speed challenge - Take two packs of playing cards and remove the kings. Turn over two cards and ask children to multiply the numbers together (Ace = 1, Jack = 11, Queen = 12). How many questions can you answer in 2 minutes? Practice regularly - can you beat your high score?
