Focus: Recognise numbers in order to 100 and beyond

Aim: By the end of this half term, children should be able to count to 100 confidently, easily and quickly.

Try starting at different numbers and asking children to continue counting on from e.g. 15.

Once they are confident counting to 100, try beyond.
