

<u>Key Instant Recall Facts</u> <u>Year 3 - Autumn 2</u>

Focus: Multiplication and division facts for the 4 times table

Aim: By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts and be able to recall these instantly.

Count in 4s			Key Vocabulary
0	$0 \times 4 = 0$		
4	1 × 4 = 4	4 ÷ 4 = 1	What is 4 times 4?
8	2 x 4 = 8	8 ÷ 4 = 2	
12	3 x 4 = 12	12 ÷ 4 = 3	What is 8 multiplied
16	4 × 4 = 16	16 ÷ 4 = 4	by 4?
20	5 x 4 = 20	20 ÷ 4 = 5	
24	6 x 4 = 24	24 ÷ 4 = 6	What is 24 divided
28	7 x 4 = 28	28 ÷ 4 = 7	by 4?
32	8 x 4 = 32	32 ÷ 4 = 8	
36	9 x 4 = 36	36 ÷ 4 = 9	What is 12 divided
40	10 × 4 = 40	40 ÷ 4 = 10	into groups of 4?
44	11 × 4 = 44	44 ÷ 4 = 11	
48	12 × 4 = 48	48 ÷ 4 = 12	

Children should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions. E.g. $4 \times ? = 16$ or $? \div 4 = 7$

Top Tips/Activity ideas

Little and **often** is the best way for children to retain these key facts. Practice them whilst on the way to school, during a car journey or at the kitchen table.

Double and double again - multiplying a number by 4 is the same as doubling and doubling again. Double 6 is 12 and double 12 is 24, so $6 \times 4 = 24$
